Please can you ensure your children wear old clothes that they don't mind getting dirty. They can also bring in an apron for messy activities if desired. It would also be advisable to wear sensible footwear such as trainers. During wet play days, it would be advisable for children to bring a towel and spare set of clothes for the activity. We do have water bomb balloons and some smaller water pistols, however, should your child want to bring their own, please make sure it is labelled and that they are responsible for them. As we will be playing outside for a considerable amount of time, please can you ensure your child has sun cream and a sunhat.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle although squash and small snacks will be provided during break times. On Friday we will be providing a BBQ lunch comprising of burgers and sausages plus a vegetarian option with ice lollies also. There will be an additional charge of £3.00 to cover the cost of this, alternatively your child can bring a packed lunch as normal.

Groups will take part alternately in the morning and afternoon activities unless it is a trip.

The cinema trip does have an additional charge of £3.00 for the ticket although we will provide popcorn and drinks. By booking this day, you are agreeing that your child can watch a PG film.

The Cotswold Wildlife Park trip will also incur an additional charge of £16.00. We have managed to match the price that we charged last time we visited, 2 years ago. This includes entry, ice cream, a trip on their train whilst there and subsidised coach travel also. There will be a 1 to 6 adult child ratio on the day.

Should any of days be oversubscribed, priority will be given on a first come basis and whether other days in the week have been booked. Early Club activities will include board games/Lego and the opportunity for supervised indoor play activities. Late Club will include an extra snack and drinks. Activities will include art/craft, access to board games, Lego, and build activities. There will also be films available to watch on the projector screen which can be up to PG rated.
