Dear Parents and Carers

Hello everyone. It was great to meet the Year 6 parents this week and thank you for your positive comments about some of the changes so far. The point about communication from classes cropped up again and so I have moved it up my agenda. Currently the infants use 'Homeroom' which is an effective way of sharing information with the class but doesn't help with the communication directly with the class teacher. Therefore, I would like to introduce 'Class Dojo', a communication app that I have used for many years in other schools. It allows the parent / carer to have the app on their phone or through a web address and directly and confidentially message the teacher and vice versa. No-one else can see these. It also has the whole class message board for the teacher to post reminders to all children but importantly it has a whole school message facility as well. Further details will be sent out next week with all the GDPR information. To work effectively, the whole school has to join but you have the right to specify no photos of your child to be shared - this will all be part of the consent form.

I hope this will help you to feel more a part of your child's learning at The Batt.

A couple of other bits of news - I met with our Trust team this week to look at the site and plans for the future. I am aware that parking is an issue, play space for the children and security. In the first instance we are going to be having CCTV put up around the school as well as looking at making the front entrance gates higher.

This brings me onto the plans and priorities for our school. I have to create a School Development Plan for the school and to do this I would very much like to hear your views on your experience of The Batt. Over the last few years, what have been the great successes that we should build on, continue etc and what are areas we could be doing better? I would appreciate any written comments, emails etc that help in this area. Similarly, if you are a parent who would like to be part of a School Development committee, I would value this.

So have a wonderful weekend and enjoy the sunshine. I, myself, am taking my youngest off to university for the first time.
