Dear Parents and Carers

Firstly, I want to thank you all for your understanding and patience regarding the Covid cases within school. We totally understand that it can cause worry and uncertainty. As a school, we sometimes have to be reactive as well as proactive and this changes due to the information we receive. We are in contact with Public Health, England every day and they are giving us the most up to date guidance. Currently we have been advised to keep air flowing and regular hand washing. In addition, there is a deep clean of the whole school taking place and we are keeping all classes separate for lunches and not holding any Collective Worship in the hall. We will continue to review this on a daily basis. You can help us as well by testing the children if they have any symptoms and by communicating with us the minute you have any positive results. Masks were never mandated in primary schools, but we are encouraging any child that feels anxious to wear one.

In other news, we held interviews this week for our new Head of School. We had an extremely strong field and we will send you a biography as soon as we can. The school also had a two-day external review for which we will share the findings when we receive them.
